Dear Winterberry Parents,
For the last 10 weeks, our World Languages classes in grades 5-8 have been exploring cultures around the world and learning about the intricate connections between land, people, climate, history and ways of life.

Students are now completing a creative, immersive capstone project in which they invent an island country from their imagination, complete with traditional food, clothing, customs, festivals and holidays.

To celebrate their projects, we will hold a World Cultures Fair on Thursday, April 28th from 10:30am-11:30am in front of the school building. Parents of students in grades 5-8 are invited to attend and browse the displays at their leisure during this time.

Students will display maps of their island and information about their island's language and culture for visitors to enjoy. They will also be dressed in their traditional clothing to welcome guests and perform an entertainment offering. Some groups may choose to provide bite-sized samples of their island's traditional food, though this is optional.
