- Polaris is a small program within the Anchorage School District and does not have a transportation or bus budget. Polaris families commit to transporting students to and from school.

- 3. Polaris Intensives have been a unique and highly valued pillar of the program since its inception. Intensive students are usually traveling in small numbers, often making district transportation cost prohibitive. Restrictions on private transportation drastically alter, limit, and even eliminate intensive opportunities.
- 4. , in order for Polaris students to participate equitably in ASD opportunities and events with other larger and differently funded schools, consideration should be given to transportation options that are feasible and
